

# Training Course for Civil Judges gets underway in FJA on “Law of Evidence”

Evidence is Fundamental to any decision in a case, Director General, Federal Judicial Academy

A five-day Training Course started at Federal Judicial Academy, Islamabad on Monday on the “Law of Evidence” for Civil Judges-Judicial Magistrate from all over Pakistan, including Gilgit-Baltistan, Azad Jammu & Kashmir and Officers from JAG Branch of Pakistan Air force.

The course was inaugurated by Director General of the Academy Mr. Hayat Ali Shah. In his address the importance of evidence in dispensation of justice was highlighted. He informed the participants that although majority of them are already acquainted with the process of recording and interpreting evidence, yet during the course, an effort would be made to refresh the knowledge of the participants through discussion of new skills, methods and processes. The resource persons will share their experiences in this regard with the participants.

Selected topics include ‘Evidence, Relevancy and Admissibility’, Evidence, Recording and Appreciation’, ‘Mode of Proof-Islamic Perspective’, ‘Judicial Notice and Presumptions’, ‘Controlling Cross Examination’, ‘Forensic Evidence’, ‘Importance of Digital Evidence’ among others.

Sessions will include instructions, syndicate discussions, study circles and videos. Additionally, twenty-five trainees will also be taken for a visit to Supreme Court of Pakistan and Local Excursion during this five-day training at the Academy.
