The subjects/topics like “Effective Role of Superintendents in Office”, “Professional Ethics”, “Time Management”, “Scrutiny of Complaint, Memorandum of Appeal and Petitions”, “Role of Superintendents in Criminal Matters including issuance of warrants and Release Orders”, “Overview of Budget/ Travelling Allowance/ Pension/ Leave Rules”, “Office Management”, “Proceeding disciplinary cases”, “Selected Provisions of Law of Limitation,” Court Fee, Suit Valuation and Stamp Act”, “Computer Orientation/Literacy, amongst others, are incorporated in this five days long training course to enhance their effectiveness. Syndicate Discussion, Group Presentation, Local Excursion and Academy Night also form a salient feature of this training.
