Finance, accounting crucial elements in administration: Fakhar Hayat

SOUND FINANCIAL MANAGEMENT IS CRUCIAL FOR DISTRICT & SESSIONS JUDGES: DG, FJA

Mr. Fakhar Hayat, Director General, Federal Judicial Academy, said that finance, accounting and budgeting were crucial elements in all types of administrative ventures, therefore, knowledge on Financial Management was important for District and Sessions Judges who become the heads of district judiciary.

He expressed these views in the inaugural ceremony of a one-week training course on “Role of District and Sessions Judges being Non-Financial Managers in Financial Management and New Laws” for Newly Promoted District and Sessions Judges from all over Pakistan, Azad Jammu and Kashmir and Gilgit-Baltistan on Monday.

He said, “This is a pragmatically conceptualized and conceived course, covering each and every topic, for effective management and administration. The over-arching goal of this training course is to build an understanding of the financial management, you will have opportunity to learn the all facets of Financial Management. I personally believe that ignorance in Financial Management and also in New Laws and emerging trends and skills would invite serious trouble for the effective functioning of the organisation and expeditious dispensation of justice.
