Islamabad: A one-week training course on “Continuing Legal Education: Professional Development Package for Members of the Bar” was launched at the Federal Judicial Academy, Islamabad, on August 26, 2019.

Speaking at the launch, Director General of the Academy, Mr. Hayat Ali Shah said, “The legal profession occupies a vital position in our administration of justice system. Without having well-groomed lawyers who are learned in law in the true sense, having deep understanding of various subjects and respectable in their conduct, our courts will not be able to administer justice effectively.”

They must strive to protect and advance the interests of their client(s) in the best possible manner and also respect the law no matter the situation so as to earn respect and honour in the society.”

Akin to the first batch, 30 trainee lawyers both male and female lawyers from Islamabad District Bar Association will benefit from this weeklong training at the FJA.
