**WORKSHOPS, SEMINARS ENHANCE EFFICIENCY,
RESOURCEFULNESS, COMPETENCE: DG, FJA**

ISLAMABAD: There is a dire need for building law officers capacity in the country in order to improve their performance and, implicitly, improve the overall administration of justice.

This was stated by Mr. Fakhar Hayat, Director General, Federal Judicial Academy, in the inaugural ceremony of a three-day capacity building workshop/seminar for enhancing capacity of law officers in collaboration with Ministry of Law and Justice on Monday.

He said, "I personally believe that the end result of successful capacity building initiatives should be effective and transformative training and learning. In order to build your capacity, the Academy as per its mandate has to provide the necessary resources, materials and 'tools' that are required to teach and train effectively. For all practical purposes, building law officer capacity is, ultimately, engendering development, growth and excellence within our legal- judicial system.
