

Prosecutors Receive Training at FJA

Prosecutors belong to noble profession of law: Mr. Fakhar Hayat, Director General, FJA

“Prosecutors belong to the noble profession of law. They are not only law officers but they are also officers of the court and their role is to conduct a neutral, unbiased prosecution,” said Mr. Fakhar Hayat, Director General, Federal Judicial Academy, formally inaugurating a one-week training course for Prosecutors from all over Pakistan including the National Accountability Bureau and Officers from the Judge Advocate General Branch of the Pakistan Air Force.

DG of the Academy stated that, “The objective of this training course is to develop the prosecutors' skills for dealing with criminal cases in an expeditious and effective manner.”

A total of 32 participants are undergoing this weeklong training titled, “Role of Prosecutors in Quick Disposal of Criminal Cases” at the Academy. Of these 5 prospectors are from the National Accountability Bureau and 3 are from the JAG branch of the Pakistan Air Force.
