Federal Judicial Academy, Islamabad invites Research Papers, Articles, Short Notes, Book Reviews, Case Commentaries and other such submissions from Hon'ble Judges, Judicial Officers, Legal Academicians, Practitioners, Researchers, Law Interns and Students for its upcoming volume of Federal Law Journal (FLJ). The Manuscripts sent must be under the Scope of Law, contemporary legal issues, Judicial education or/and legal education and related fields.

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

1. The submission must not be previously published or currently under review at any other Journal/Conference/Book etc. and should not be submitted to any other Journal/Conference while in process of review with us. Read this point carefully, kindly do not submit the same paper at many places.
2. The submission must be the original work of the author(s) i.e. shouldn't be plagiarized and also should be free from grammatical, spelling and other errors. It must also not contain any defamatory words.
3. Submission must be accompanied by an abstract of not more than 300 words and author(s) affiliation. No Paper will be accepted without abstract.
4. We do not follow any strict rule regarding citations. However, citations are still required and citations through hyperlinks are mostly encouraged. And for footnotes and endnotes we prefer OSCOLA (Oxford Standard for the Citation of Legal Authorities) citation standards.
5. Co-authorship is permitted to a maximum of 3 authors.
6. Federal Law Journal holds copyright over all contents published in the website. Any unauthorized use of the contents would be considered as a violation of copyright.
7. Submissions must be sent through electronic means only. All submissions must be emailed to submissions.fja@gmail.com
8. All submissions must be made in .doc format. No pdf format shall be entertained.

The submissions may be made under the following categories; the word limit is exclusive of footnotes:

- Research Paper: 3000-3500 words
- Book/Case Reviews: 1500-3000 words
- Short Note & Case Comment: 1000 – 2000 words

SUBMISSION POLICY

- a) The Editorial Board will follow the Peer-Review Policy for judging the submissions.
- b) The Editorial Board reserves the right to reject or edit any paper whose content is offensive or defamatory, explicitly unethical or if it supports racism, sexual or religious discrimination, illegal activities or terrorism; similarly an article may be refused if the Editorial Board deems that it might harm the political or religious sentiments of any segments of the society in any manner.
- c) The Editorial Board reserves the right to reject the paper on account of plagiarism.
- d) The research paper should not infringe the copyright or any other right of a third party, if so, the Federal Judicial Academy disclaims any responsibility for copyright violation or any other liability.
